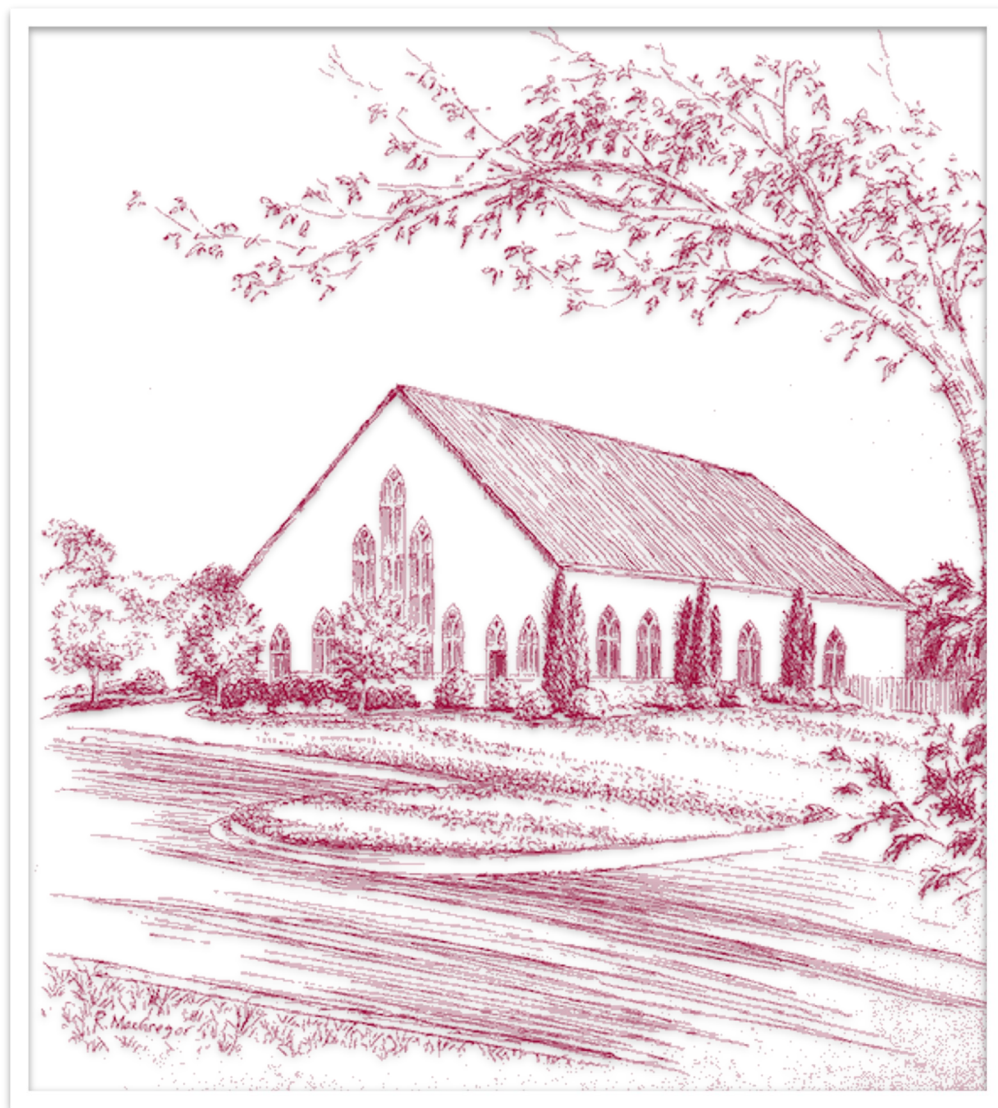

Nicene Creed
