

#### Confession of Faith

Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible. 
### "Holy Spirit, Living Breath of God"

Holy Spirit, breathe new life in me.


Holy Spirit, come abide within
